
## Anglican Rosary for Fridays




## Friday - A Prayer for Forgiveness and Healing

On the Invitatory. (First Pass)	Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me
On the Cruciforms	Holy God, Holy and Mighty, Holy immortal one, have mercy upon me
On the Weeks.	Lord Jesus Christ, son of the living God, have mercy on me, a sinner.
On the last Invitatory.	You have made me glad by your acts, O Lord, and I shout for joy because of the works of Your hand.
On the Cross.	Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your Name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. Save us from the time of trial, and deliver us from evil. Amen
